What STUDENTS need to know

There are two options to enroll – (1) traditional full-time students/Interns and (2) self-guided students

Traditional Full-time Students

- This is no joke. Put out of your mind a typical church “internship.”
- This **is** a robust two or four year University Program offered by Northwest University. One Church Northwest University student with the same academic standing, earning the same degrees as students on NU’s Kirkland campus.
- All of your time is strategically organized to maximize your education and experience
- The approach considers all the ways students learn and seeks to develop skilled, educated, and mature Christians through:
 - **Rigorous Education**
 - Full-Time (30 Credits per year), accredited Northwest University coursework
 - Offering two-year degrees in General Studies (AA) and Ministry Leadership (AML), and a
 - four-year degree (BAML) Bachelor's of Arts in Ministry Leaderships
 - **Personal Coaching and Development:**
 - Practice the classic spiritual disciplines in the pursuit of holiness and intimacy with God. Students can expect a strong code of conduct & expectations
 - Self-Leadership, Personality and calling
 - Physical, emotional, and financial fitness
 - Real world skills like changing tires and planning menus
 - **Hands-on Practicum Education and Ministry Experience**
 - In addition to coursework students will also select a complementary ministry track in (1) Children’s, (2) Youth, (3) Worship, Creative Arts, & Technology, or (4) Church Planting.
 - Tracked Ministry Experience is equivalent to one course per semester. This is curriculum driven service FOR CREDIT, not moving chairs.
 - Working alongside the staff of One Church in immersive mentoring, and
 - Ministering within our Community as well as supporting the world mission of the Gospel.
- Applications are accepted from January 1, 2016 through June 30, 2016.
 - Applications are available online at www.VisitOneChurch.com/sml or on campus
 - Standard minimum GPA is 2.5; students with lower GPA may be admitted on probation.
 - Interested students should begin their FAFSA and financial aid processing as soon as possible even if you are just thinking about the program.

- Tuition and Fees are only **\$9,536 per year!**
